Osteoporosis medications approved by the FDA for corticosteroid-induced osteoporosis include: Actonel (Risedronate) for prevention and treatment Fosamax (Alendronate) for treatment In corticosteroid users, both drugs deliver beneficial effects on spine and hip bone mineral density and are associated with a decrease in spinal fractures.

### Corticosteroid-Induced Osteoporosis Overview

Corticosteroid-Induced Osteoporosis. Many people with joint or muscle pain, breathing or intestinal ailments use corticosteroids (e.g., Prednisone or methylprednisolone). However, long-term use of these drugs can cause osteoporosis (loss of bone density) and fractures.

### Corticosteroid-Induced Osteoporosis - Cedars-Sinai

Osteoporosis is one of the most serious complications of corticosteroid treatment. Loss of bone mineral density (BMD) and fractures occur early in the course of corticosteroid treatment, and thus early recognition of fracture risk and effective intervention based on evidence-based-medicine (EBM) are needed.

### Prevention and Treatment of Corticosteroid-Induced ...

Between 30 and 50 percent of patients taking long-term corticosteroids will experience fractures. Today, fractures due to corticosteroid-induced osteoporosis may be prevented. A number of well-designed randomized controlled trials have been conducted that demonstrate preservation and, in some instances, actual increases in bone mass with the use of appropriate drug treatment.

### Corticosteroid-induced osteoporosis.

Patients on or about to start CS use for more than 6 months are at risk of corticosteroid-induced osteoporosis (CIOP). The pathogenesis of CIOP differs from post-menopausal osteoporosis in that bone formation is said to be more suppressed compared with bone resorption.

### Management of corticosteroid-induced osteoporosis ...

prednisone Steroid-induced osteoporosis is osteoporosis arising due to use of glucocorticoids (steroid hormones) - analogous to Cushing's syndrome and involving mainly the axial skeleton. The synthetic glucocorticoid prescription drug prednisone is a main candidate after prolonged intake.

### Challenges in Defining Quality of Care for Glucocorticoid ...

Most gen med guidelines recognize a daily oral dose of >5-7.5mg prednisolone for more than three months as conferring an increased risk of osteoporosis. Adults >40 receiving high dose intermittent steroids (at least one daily dose of >15mg for a short duration) are at risk when the cumulative dose exceeds 1g. (Source: UK GP Database)
